Information of the FCI MRUD section meeting in Asti on 9th October 2008

(MRUD = Mondioring Utility Dogs)

Super selection in Virton la Tour, Saturday p.m. and Sunday, 7th/8th March 2009

registration fee : 30 E, one meal offered to the participator
judges : 1 Swiss, 1 Belgian, 1 Frenchman

2 additional members of the section will be present, Mr. Oppizzi (Italy) and Mr. Alvès (Portugal).

A physical test and a test of the knowledge of the rules will take place.

The judges do not adjudicate the candidates of their own countries.

World Cup in Virton la Tour (B) from 1st to 4th October 2009

Organisation: Mr. Gérard Mullenders

Procedure : Thursday cat. 1 and 2, Grand Prix (1 dog per country and category, to be announced by the competitors' national federation subject to the dog having already participated in the category announced. The organising country proposes 3 judges for these categories. The section chooses 2 judges of different nationalities therefore at their meeting on 7th March 2009. The decoys will be chosen following the results of the super selection subject to having achieved a grade not under VG (very good).

The World Cup will take place during 3 days with a trial dog as well as the drawing of the first two competitors on Thursday evening. Every dog is to perform the whole program in one run. The number of participants is limited to 50. 5 dogs plus one reserve are allowed per country. According to the number of participants announced by the national federations before the 1st September, the definitive number of competitors will be decided on by the section and the organizer. The judges will be discussed at the meeting on 7th March and proposed to the FCI-UC accordingly.

Functional Specifications

Functional specifications have been elaborated and unanimously accepted by the section. They will be forwarded to President Frans Jansen.

Rule Book

The rules with the amendments of «La Tour» will be proposed to the FCI-UC.
