Minutes of the 22^e meeting SMUDC/FCI 23 February 2018 Vendenheim - France

The meeting started at 14:00hrs.

The Coordinator welcomed and thanked the delegates that were present.

The Coordinator excused the president of the UDCFCI and representative for the Netherlands due to a car break down. The coordinator deplors that the President of the UDCFCI was not present for a third time sequentially.

2.

The agenda started with a review of the minutes from the last meeting, 21st meeting of SMUDC/FCI on 04 October 2017 in Gornitz – Spain. The presentation of the minutes was given by the Secretary in English and French. There were no remarks, the minutes were unanimously accepted.

3.

The Coordinator confirmed that that the German Kennel Club has given an invitation for an international judge to judge a trial in their country. In addition the Austrian Kennel Club has also given invitation to the Kennel Club for the same.

The coordinator requested to the present delegates, that the international judges from their own country will respect/honour the request of the Kennel Club from which they are invited.

4.

A request was given to the present delegates of Greece and Poland that they create an official procedure for the qualification and Brevet of Mondioring decoys in their Country and accepted by their Kennel Club. In addition they must also ask their Kennel Club to create a procedure for the formation of Mondioring judges.

5.

The Coordinator congratulated and thanked the 2017 organizer - M. Ricardo Salazar.

The World Championship and Grand Prix 2017 happened in Spain Gorniz without incidents or injuries to any of the decoys or the dogs. The coordinator thanked all of the competitors for their exemplary comportment during this world championship.

The International selection for decoys also happened without incidents under the responsibility of M. Stephan Huber.

No evolution for Denmark and Norway in the file of acceptance of the Mondioring program.

8.

The case M. Erb and Switzerland, the majority wants to send the case to the next meeting of the UDCFCI for decision-making, the Coordinator will contact the president of the UDCFCI.

9.

Regarding the implementation of a Mondioring commission regardless of the UDC-FCI - In the absence of the President of the UDC-FCI there was no further information / update. The Coordinator declared that at the next meeting of the UDC-FCI an official request will be introduced.

10.

International selection for decoys - There is a proposal to restrain/limit the candidates on the second day of selection. The majority in the meeting agrees with the suggestion but commencing in 2019. The proposal is, if there are more than 25 participants, the second day is limited to the 20 first candidates classified on the first day.

11.

World Championship and Grand Prix 2019 Poland - We have received an official written request by the Polish Kennel Club. M. Marcin Gawron, representative for Poland confirms.

12.

Organization for 2020 - During the 19th meeting there was a declaration given by the Netherlands to host the World Championships, an official written request is required.

Distributed a copy of the note made and signed by the president of the UC/FCI M. Frans Jansen and the coordinator of the SMUDC/FCI M. Bernard Roser.

The note is giving a judge the authorization to judge members of their own family in trials where they are judging, alongside a second judge. The second judge is not allowed to be a family member of the competitor. In order to respect these conditions, it is necessary in every category for two judges.

This document was realized for the wellness of the sport and because there are countries where judges are married (co-habit) or related to family members that also practice the discipline of Mondioring.

The Security of the dog and the decoys - The protection suit of the decoys G.P. and W.C. and the participants of the international selection will be controlled. A report of the control will be established by the responsible judge.

A reminder of the decisions mad at the meeting in Fubine (Italy) 2008:

The protective suit :

It must effectively protect the decoy, it must be flexible, allowed the decoy to make easy moves and to run with flexibility.

The suit may not be ridiculous, it may not have the sleeves too wide, and it may not be too hard that it prevent the bite of the dog .

It must allow to the dog a bite for at least 7 cm depth and at least, a thickness of the suit in the mouth of the dog of 3 à 5 cm.

It's an interdiction for the decoy to change his suit during a test in function for one or other dog.
