Minutes of the 23^e meeting SMUDC/FCI 03 October 2018 Moscow - Russia

The meeting starts at 6 PM.

The Coordinator welcomes and thanks the present delegates and declare that Germany don't have a delegate. The German Kennel Club will appoint an official delegate next year. Mr. Frans Jansen, delegate for Netherlands and president of the UDC/FCI commission, welcomes the present delegates and confirms, that by the unanimously decision in the commission UDC/FCI about the implementation of a Commission Mondioring, separate of the UDC/FCI.

He has send, on behave of the FCI Utility Dog Commission, a proposal to the FCI General Committee, to form a FCI Mondioring Commission. This proposal will be on the next meeting of the General Committee in November 2018 and will be forwarded, with a recommendation of the General Committee, to the agenda of the next meeting of the General Assembly in 2019. A copy of the letter will be send in appendix with the minutes.

2.

The agenda started with a review of the minutes from the last meeting, 22st meeting of SMUDC/FCI on 23 February 2018 in Vendenheim – France. The presentation of the minutes was given by the Secretary in English and French. There were no remarks, the minutes were unanimously accepted.

3.

Portugal: The President of the UDC/FCI will ask for some information at the Portuguese Kennel club about the development of the new structure Mondioring in their country under the aegis of the Portuguese Kennel Club, and ask who will be the delegate in the SMUDC/FCI.

4.

Presentation of the progress of the World Championship and the International trial level 1&2 Mondioring 2018 by Marianna Gladcick delegate in the UDC/FCI commission for Russia.

5.

The letters of accreditation made by the OCN, ones more we insist that the OCN of the countries who accepted this discipline send the letters of accreditation to the FCI office. The FCI bureau will send a copy to the Secretary of the SMUDCFI and to the Coordinator.

6.

Worthy dress for judges during the W.C. 2018: there are no more ties, and scarfs at this moment.

7.

Presentation of the progress of the international decoy selection 2018 by the responsible M. Martial Beyaert. Twenty-four participants coming out of eight different countries.

8.

Security of the decoys and dogs. Control of the protective suits, for the decoys of the World Championship and G.P. also of the participants at the international decoy selection.

9.

The invoice of the web site 2018-2019 was € 46,56 was prepaid by the secretary Mr. V. Linclau. As agreed in the past it's the organizer of the next year who take it in charge, till now Poland didn't refund the invoice.

10.

The coordinator adds a point to the agenda: FCI circular 55/2015 which stipulates the minimum guidelines to become Judge Mondioring, and the minimum requirements to fulfill to become International judge FCI Mondioring and the rules that must be respected by FCI judges Mondioring. Delegates are requested to inform their OCN and to send annually a list of judges considered by their OCN as international – this means those who fulfill the conditions mentioned in the point international judges Mondioring FCI circular 55/2015 – and who obtain permission from their OCN to judge in other countries. The list must be sent to the FCI office. The Coordinator recalls that each OCN is responsible for judges as well as for the decoys of their country. The delegates must inform their OCN that each decoy of their country must be in possession of a decoy book issued by their OCN.

The meeting is declared closed at 07.30PM.

Next meeting of the SMUDC/FCI on Saturday 16 February 2019 at 02.00 PM in Racibórz- Poland at the place of the next World Championship 2019.
